Napa Valley College administers the G.E.D. according to the schedule below. Applicants must register in person at the Testing and Tutoring Center, Room 862, (location subject to change after June, 2010) at Napa Valley College.

****EACH GROUP IS LIMITED TO THE FIRST 20 PEOPLE WHO REGISTER**

Registration is applicable only for the test dates immediately following the registration week.

REGISTRATION: Registration must be done in person with a Picture ID; the test must be paid for at that time, **cash only** (no checks). Allow 30 minutes to complete the registration process.

Acceptable picture ID: Driver's license, passports, military or other government identification cards are acceptable. Identification cards issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles and the Matricula Consular cards are also acceptable forms of identification.

****You may not take the tests without presenting the same picture ID at the testing sessions.**

PREPARING FOR THE G.E.D.: We encourage you to prepare for the G.E.D. Most bookstores carry books, which provide preparation for the G.E.D. Napa Valley Adult School (253-3594) offers classes in G.E.D. preparation.

RETAKES: The G.E.D. subtests may be taken a total of three times in a calendar year. If you do not pass after three attempts, you must wait until the Test Center has received the 2011 series of tests. You must register and pay for each subtest.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

1. United States residents who are **18 years or older** and who did not graduate from high school and do not have a diploma.
2. 17 year olds not enrolled in a regular or continuation high school who:
 - a. are within 60 days of their 18th birthday, OR
 - b. are within 60 days of when their class would have graduated, OR
 - c. (1) have been out of school for 60 days or more (verified in writing from an educational institution at the time of registration) AND (2) have a letter from the military, an employer, or a post-secondary institution, on official letterhead, requesting that Napa Valley College administer the G.E.D. test to the applicant. (These letters must be presented at the time of registration.)
 - d. No one younger than 17 may be tested.

G.E.D. STATE CERTIFICATE: The California State Department of Education in Sacramento will issue you a State Certificate if you receive passing scores on the G.E.D. Please note: 17 year olds who have passed the G.E.D. will receive a letter of intent and, upon turning 18, the Certificate will be issued.

Your official test results will be mailed to you. No scores will be given by phone.

Parking permits are required and are available from the dispensers in the parking lot (\$2.00).

NOTE: If you write or mark in any of the G.E.D. test booklets you may be charged an \$80.00 replacement fee.
