



The AA-T in Elementary Teacher Education is designed to provide a clear pathway to a CSU major and baccalaureate degree. California Community College students who are awarded an AA-T or an AS-T degree are guaranteed admission with junior standing somewhere in the CSU system and given priority admission consideration to their local CSU campus or to a program that is deemed similar. This priority does not guarantee admission to specific majors or campuses. Students who have been awarded an AA-T or AS-T are able to complete their remaining requirements for the 120-unit baccalaureate degree within 60 semester units.

Please note: All students have to choose between the IGETC pattern or CSU GE pattern to complete their GE requirements for the AA-T degree. Please see the most recent information on the main college website, schedule and/or catalog, or get help with specific requirements from a counselor.
