To receive an ASNVC scholarship, students must complete the following:

- A. Complete the NVC 2021-2022 Scholarship Application front page (see page 2).**
- B. Complete a 1 page Cover Letter answering the following questions:**
 - 1) How long have you served in ASNVC? What positions have you held?
 - 2) How did serving on the ASNVC Board benefit your life outside of NVC (education, career, and personal life)?
 - 3) What is your greatest achievement in ASNVC?
- C. Complete an ASNVC Resume listing only ASNVC Related Activities and specifically how you engaged in those activities (see Resume example pages 4-6).**
- D. Complete Graduation Stole Request (see page 3).**

Scholarship Requirements

1. **MUST** have completed 5 units at NVC by the end of the Fall 2021 semester (do not include Spring 2022 units).
2. **MUST** have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 at NVC by the end of the Fall 2021 semester.
3. **MUST** maintain enrollment in 5 units at NVC during the Spring 2022 semester.
4. **MUST** have served a minimum of one completed semester in the ASNVC to be eligible for scholarship and stole.
5. **MUST** be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen (Note: International Students are not eligible).
6. **MUST** be in good standing with the college and Financial Aid.
7. **MUST NOT** have received an ASNVC Scholarship before.
8. **MUST** only apply for an ASNVC Graduation Stole **ONCE**. The stole will be white with green lettering. It will say "ASNVC and the years you served in ASNVC."

Scholarships range from \$500 and up. Applicants will be judged on:

- I. Amount of Volunteer Activities/Projects
- II. Time serving in ASNVC
- III. Good standing in ASNVC
- IV. G.P.A. (to be used as a tiebreaker)

Depending on the outcome of your letters, contributions, and how many students/officers apply, each amount mentioned above is subject to change during the review.
