

## Articulation Agreement (2019 – 2020)

### Kaiser Permanente School of Allied Health Sciences (KPSAHS) and Napa Valley College

**Introduction:**

KPSAHS offers baccalaureate degrees in diagnostic medical sonography, nuclear medicine, and radiologic technology which require specific program prerequisites be completed prior to admissions. The chart below identifies courses accepted as program prerequisites in effect at time of signing. Additional courses accepted for pre-requisites may be reflected in the KPSAHS Transfer Credit Database<sup>1</sup> also published on [www.kpsahs.edu](http://www.kpsahs.edu). Students must earn a grade of C or higher in prerequisite courses, and the course (or courses) used to fulfill each prerequisite must be a minimum of 3 semester or 4 quarter credits.




