Our Mission

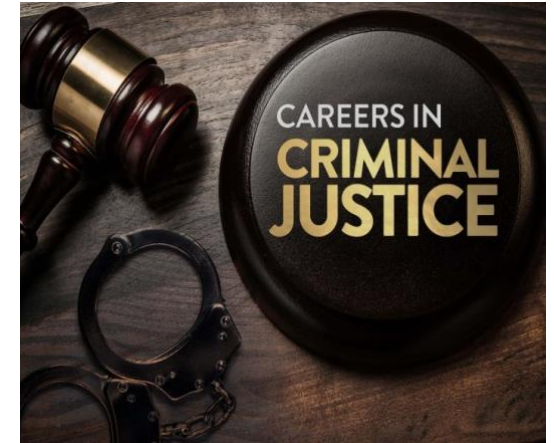
The Administration of Justice Program provides quality instruction for transfer, degree, and occupational students.
