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Please bring all applicable documents

- Student's SOCIAL SECURITY CARD or NUMBER
- Student's DRIVER'S LICENSE
- Student's Permanent Resident Card
- Parent's SOCIAL SECURITY CARD or NUMBER
- Independent Student: Your Federal Income Tax Return (form 1040) and W-2 forms for 2021, and (your spouse's Tax Return and W-2 forms if you are married).
- Dependent Student: Your parent's Federal Income Tax Return (form 1040) and W-2 forms for 2021.
- Students, if you had a job in 2021 and you are not required to file a Federal Tax Return, please bring your W-2 forms or, if you do not have your W-2 forms, bring other records of the income you earned that year, such as check stubs.
- Records of other untaxed income received, such as workman's compensation, disability, child- support, veteran's benefits, military or clergy allowance, assets, etc. received during the 2021 calendar year.
- If you have a checking or savings account, please have the current value of these accounts.
- If you have stocks, bonds, trust accounts or other investments, please have the current value of these assets.
- If you own a business or investment farm, please have the NET value of these assets.
- A list of colleges and universities you may be interested in attending during the 2023-2024 academic year.

Even if you do not have all or any of the items above, please participate in the workshop. Financial Aid staff will be available to answer any questions and help get you started on the process of applying. Students can still submit Financial Aid Applications for the 2022-2023 academic year; documents of the year 2020 are needed.
