

Suggested Course Sequence For Degree and Certificates

To help students with their educational planning, faculty may choose to list a sequence of courses in the catalog that will help students plan how to complete their degree in two years' time.

- Using the approved courses from your outline in CurricUNET, begin to assign them in the sequence you feel students should complete them, by semester.
 - It may be easier to assign your required courses and electives to a semester sequence before you begin adding in GE information.
 - Only list your required courses in the semester sequence. For GE or elective courses, list out the title of the requirement being met (not a specific course). So you might say "UBW Degree Required Electives" instead of UBW-124 or 126 or 128. Or you might say "English Composition" instead of "ENGL-120" (unless that is a required course in your degree).
- Select your GE (general education) pattern.
 - If you have a local degree (A.A. or A.S.) you must use the NVC GE pattern to complete the GE requirements.
 - If you have a transfer degree (A.A.-T. or A.S.-T) you can choose the CSU GE pattern or the IGETC pattern. Students must complete one of these options to earn their degree.
- Think about when you typically offer the required courses. Are they offered each semester, or just fall or spring?
- Note any courses that contain prerequisites, and allow for the prerequisite course to be completed prior to the required course.
- Remember that Area E of the NVC GE pattern can double count for other areas of the GE pattern for A.S. degrees.
- Remember additional **graduation requirements**, such as the American History/Institutions Requirement for A.A. degrees, the Physical Education/Health Requirement, etc.
