

Job Description of AS Professional Learning Committee (Ad Hoc) Fall, 2022

Professional Learning Committee (Ad Hoc) will develop and implement the Center for Equity and Excellence in Teaching and Learning (CEETL). CEETL is comprised of:

1. Faculty Enrichment Programs, including Instructional Excellence Days (Flex Day), sabbaticals, and PD grants to fund conferences and workshops.
2. AS Instructional Design Institute, including continuing curriculum development in DE Pedagogy and CRP Pedagogy.
3. AS Governance Institute, including professional learning curricula for New Faculty Learning Community, mentoring activities, and campus outreach.
4. Professional Learning Research Team, to support training needs of faculty; determine future trends in pedagogy and policies that impact the classroom; assess and report effectiveness of faculty professional learning.

The PLC (Ad hoc) will also draft language to recommend AS bylaws revision to Article 5, Section 3
