### PAYMENT AND REFUND POLICIES:

- Students are required to pay their balance by the Unified De-Registration Date prior to the start of the term. If registering after that date, students are de-registered nightly for unsettled accounts. All students are responsible for ensuring that their drop has been processed, use Self-Service to review your records.
- See above for Drop with a Refund Deadline for courses that have begun.
- Drop with refund policy is applicable only to the \$46/unit enrollment fee. Other NVC fees are non-refundable after classes begin. See the NVC Fees and Refunds page online.
- Refunds for international and non-resident tuition are 100% for the first two weeks, 50% on the 3<sup>rd</sup> week and 25% the fourth week.
