American Canyon Arts Foundation (ACAF) seeks a Napa Valley College art student for a paid internship with them during the Spring and Summer 2025 semester. Chosen student will gain work experience, learn about the non-profit art world, assist with events and social media, and create promotional materials for both digital and print platforms.

Description: Student should have interest in the arts, ability to assist with events, know basic graphic design elements and principles to utilize Canva. Student will be supervised by an ACAF Advisor/Mentor Board Member.

Duties: Social Media accounts – Facebook + boosts, Instagram, X, TikTok, Nextdoor AmCanHappenings, City community calendar & Chamber newsletter with clickable links, website, event assistance such as tabling, photographing or videography if possible.

Duration: 3 months, beginning April 30, ending June 30. Approximately 5 – 10 hours week, not to exceed a total of 50 hours.

Stipend: \$500 in the form of an ACAF scholarship

- *Cover letter* expressing your interest in the internship, describing your personal/academic goals and background, as well as your background in the arts
