

NAPA VALLY COLLEGE ASSOCIATE DEGREE IN NURSING PROGRAM POLICY REGARDING (ATI TEAS) Test of Essential Academic Skills

- 1. Napa Valley College Associate Degree in Nursing Program (ADN) will accept the ATI TEAS 6 or the New ATI TEAS (7) with a score of 62.0% or better, for the 2024 ADN application. After January 2024, only the New ATI TEAS (7) will be accepted for application to the Associate Degree in Nursing Program.
- 2. Applicants must create an account with www.atitesting.com. The name on the account must match valid government-issued photo I.D. that applicant presents at time of testing.
- 3. Applicant must test in a secure, proctored environment or remote testing site and must present valid government-issued photo identification. Personal belongings, calculators and all other electronic items are not allowed in the testing area.
- 4. Check the ATI website to schedule a TEAS test at any testing location. Only official transcript results received directly from ATI Testing to Napa Valley College will be accepted for all program applicants. Transcripts may be ordered at www.atitesting.com. Name of transcript must match name of record with Napa Valley College data.
- 5. Prior to testing, it is strongly suggested that you prepare for the ATI TEAS by obtaining official ATI TEAS study materials (study guides, practice exams, etc.) from the ATI website.
- 6. If you do not achieve a minimum passing score of at least 62.0% on your first TEAS exam, you are strongly encouraged to study with the online TEAS Focused Review and complete additional coursework as needed. (You can access your ATI TEAS Score Report at any time through your ATI Account under "My Results". Within that same area, next to your score report, you have the ability to create a Focused Review. A Focused Review is an online review tool that aligns question topics missed and the relevant study materials for your review).
- 7. Applicants are only allowed a maximum of three (3) attempts per year at achieving a passing adjusted individual total score of 62.0%. There must be a MINIMUM of 30 days between retakes.
