- Illness anxiety disorder (previously...)
- Conversion disorder
- Factitious disorder



Somatic Symptom Disorder

- Distressing symptoms
- Maladaptive response
- Without significant physical findings...
- Suffering is authentic
- High level of functional impairment



Illness Anxiety Disorder

- Misinterpretation of physical sensations
- Overconcerned for health & preoccupied with...
- Extreme worry and fear

Course of illness chronic and relapsing



Conversion Disorder


- Neurological symptoms in the absence of...
- Presence of deficits in...
- Common symptoms—
- "La belle indifférence" versus distress



Psychological Factors Affecting Medical Condition

- Psychological factors present risk for...
- Depression
 - Cardiovascular diseases and cancer







Etiology

- Biological factors
 - > Genetic
- Psychological factors
 - > Psychodynamic theories
 - > Behavioral theories
 - Cognitive theories
- Environmental factors
- Cultural considerations

Assessment

- Psychosocial factors
- > Coping skills
- > Spirituality and religion
- Secondary gains

Cognitive style



Application of the Nursing Process (Cont.)

- Assessment (cont.)
 - > Ability to communicate feelings and emotional needs
 - Dependence on medication
 - > Self-assessment







Application of the Nursing Process (Cont.)

- Nursing diagnosis
 - > Ineffective coping
- Outcomes identification
- Interventions
 - Psychosocial interventions
 - Promotion of self-care activities
 - Assertiveness training



Application of the Nursing Process (Cont.)

- Interventions (cont.)
 - Psychobiological interventions
 - Pharmacological interventions
 - > Health teaching and health promotion
- Case management
- Advanced nursing practice interventions



Factitious Disorders

Fabricate symptoms or self-inflict injury

Goal of assuming a sick role
