## Student Support Services



### WHAT IS EOPS?

**Extended Opportunity Programs & Services (EOPS)** provides "Over and Above" academic and personal development programs and services to students who face social, language, educational and/or economic barriers.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Resident of California or AB540 eligible
- Complete a Financial Aid Application and qualify to receive the California Promise Grant
- Enrolled in 12 or more units when accepted
- Completed less than 70 units from all colleges and universities
- Educationally disadvantaged

### WHAT IS CARE?

**The Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education (CARE)** program provides resources and support necessary for single, head of household parents.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- To qualify for CARE, students must be eligible for EOPS and meet the following criteria:
- Current recipient of CalWORKs/TANF cash aid, for yourself or your child
- At least 18 years of age or older
- Be single and head of household
- Parent at least one child

### WHAT IS NEXTUP?

**NextUp** is a program designed to connect foster youth with support services on and off the college campus to ensure a successful transition from foster care to adulthood.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Enrolled at Napa Valley College
  - Current or former foster youth who was in care on or after the age of 13
  - Provide an official verification of foster youth status
- (EOPS staff can assist with the request process)

### WHAT IS CALWORKS?

**California Work Opportunity and responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs)** is a program designed to expand existing services and provide the needed educational opportunities for eligible student parents.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

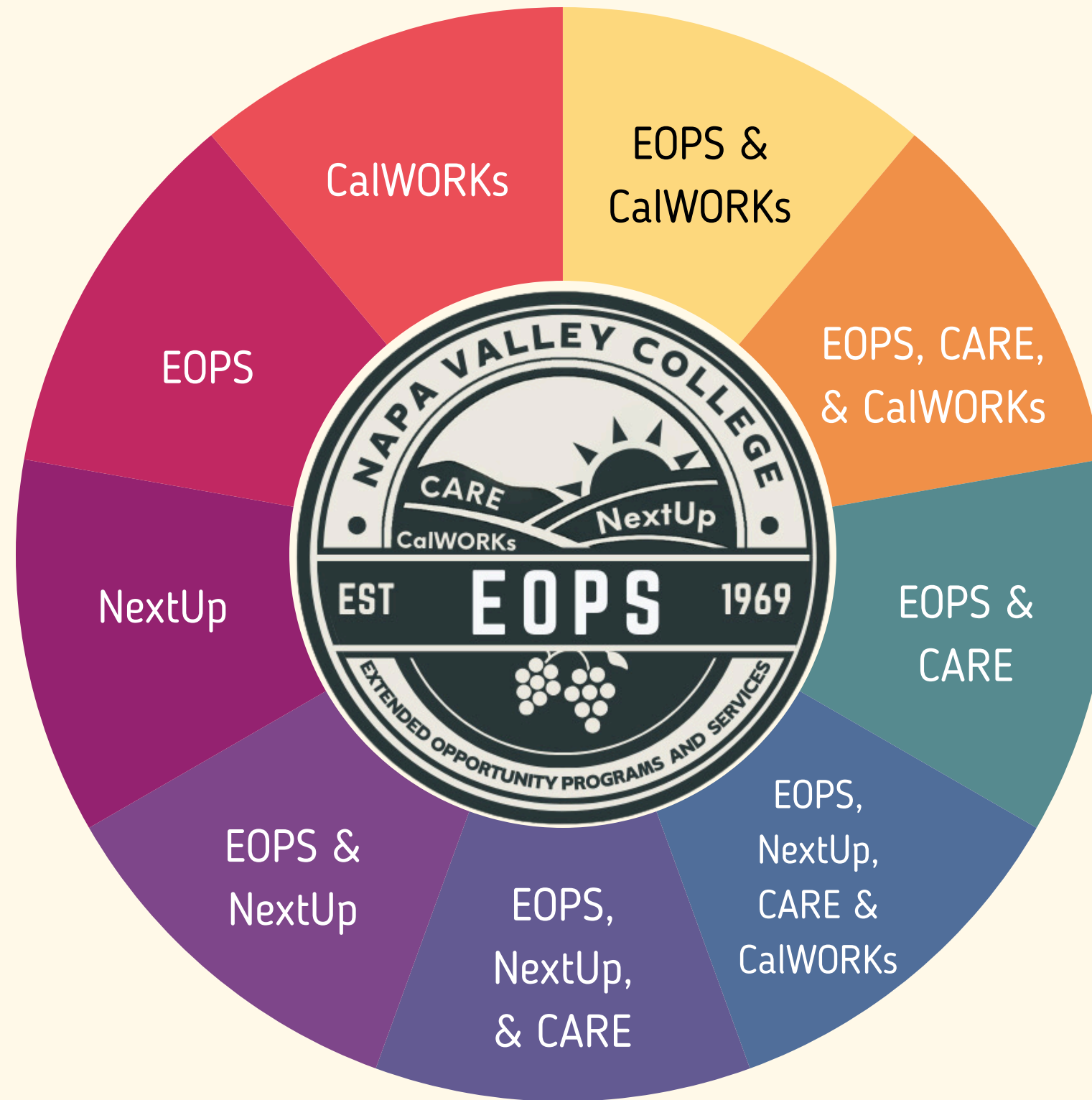
- California Resident
- Receiving CalWORKs cash aid for themselves and their child(ren)
- Parent who is at least 18 years old
- Enrolled in a class at Napa Valley College
- Provide verification of benefits
