Placement for Entry Level Math Courses

The following placements are effective starting Spring 2026

Math 106	<p>C- or higher in both semesters of HS Math III or Algebra 2 OR an unweighted cumulative HS GPA of at least 3.2.</p> <p>Students who do not meet either criterion are placed into M106 with M86.</p> <p>Students who successfully completed Calculus or Precalculus in HS are NOT allowed to enroll in M106.</p>
Math 110	<p>C- or higher in both semesters of HS Math III or Algebra 2 OR an unweighted cumulative HS GPA of at least 3.2.</p> <p>Students who do not meet either criterion are placed into M110 with M81.</p> <p>Students who do not meet the criterion for M120 are placed into M110.</p>
Math 115	<p>C- or higher in both semesters of HS Precalculus OR B- or higher in both semesters of HS Math III or Algebra 2 OR C or higher in NVC's M106 or equivalent.</p> <p>Students who do not meet the listed criterion are placed into M115 with M87 or M81.</p>
Math 120	<p>C- or higher in both semesters of HS Precalculus OR B- or higher in both semesters of HS Math III or Algebra 2 OR C or higher in both M106 and M108 or equivalent</p> <p>Students who do not meet the listed criterion are placed into M120 with M88.</p>
Math 130	<p>C- or higher in both semesters of HS Math I, Math II, Financial Algebra or Statistics OR an unweighted cumulative HS GPA of at least 2.6</p> <p>Students who do not meet either criterion are placed into M130 with M81.</p>
Stat C1000 Math 80 Math 235 (HS Only)	<p>C- or higher in both semesters of HS Math II, Financial Algebra or Statistics OR an unweighted cumulative HS GPA of at least 3.0.</p> <p>Students who do not meet either criterion are placed into SC1000 with M83.</p>

NOTE: Per AB1705 there is NO requirement for HS Grades to be current within a certain time limit.

Math 81 is a co-req for Math 130 students (required for MATH-P10). Students not enrolled in Math 130 are also welcome (for example chemistry or health occupations students who want a math refresher). This course is only offered in the spring semester.

NVC AB1705 Placement Tiers – Spring 2026

Please note that enrollment options are based on major.

MATH-P1: Allowed to take any GE math, must take co-req

MATH-P2: Required to take Tech 92 and Tech 107

MATH-P5**: Required to take M120 with co-req*

MATH-P6: Allowed to take any GE math, must take co-req if selecting M120*

MATH-P7: Allowed to take any GE math, must take co-req if selecting M106, M115, M120* or SC1000

MATH-P8: Allowed to take any GE math, must take co-req if selecting M106, M115 or M120*

MATH-P9: Allowed to take any GE math, must take co-req if selecting M115 or M120*

MATH-P10: Allowed to take any GE math, not required to take co-req

MATH-P11: Required to take M130 with co-req

MATH-P12: Required to take M130, not required to take co-req

MATH-P13: Required to take M115 or M120 with co-req*

MATH-P14: Required to take M115 or M120, not required to take co-req

MATH-P15: Required to take SC1000 with co-req

MATH-P16: Required to take M115 or M120, must take co-req if selecting M120*

MATH-P17: Required to take M115

MATH-P18: Required to take SC1000, not required to take co-req

MATH-P19: Required to take M120 with co-req*

MATH-P20: Required to take M120, not required to take co-req

*Students required to take M120 with a co-req can opt to first take M110 followed by M120

**MATH-P5 is for Chemistry students
