**Petition:** Students must meet with a Counselor to complete a Graduation Petition, and file the petition with the Admissions and Records Office before the posted deadline in the semester in which graduation is anticipated.

**Grade Average:** Students must complete at least 60 degree applicable semester units with a grade point average of at least a 2.0. Only courses numbered 90 through 399 are considered degree applicable and will be counted towards the 60 units (**except for Math 92**).
