**Petition:** Students must meet with a Counselor to complete a Graduation Petition, and file the petition with the Admissions and Records Office before the posted deadline in the semester in which graduation is anticipated.

**Grade Average:** Students must complete at least 60 degree applicable semester units with a grade point average of at least a 2.0. Only courses numbered 90 through 399 are considered degree applicable and will be counted towards the 60 units (**except for Math 92**). Total semester units completed as of . Units still required

**Residence:** Residence semester units completed as of . Units still required: Candidates must complete at least 12 semester units at Napa Valley College and be in attendance during the semester prior to graduation or have completed 30 units of work at Napa Valley College. **Major Requirements:** For an A.A. degree, students must complete at least 18 units in one discipline or related disciplines as listed in the Napa Valley College catalog. For an A.S. degree, the requirement is usually 30 or more semester units in the major, as listed in the Napa Valley College catalog. Along with major course requirements, all students pursuing an A.A. or A.S. degree must also complete general education course requirements for graduation.
